ECHO & EKG SCREENING

The echocardiogram (ECHO) & electrocardiogram (EKG) are the best tools for detection of the risks of sudden cardiac death. These tests typically cost \$1,500 and are usually not covered by insurance. Heartfelt Cardiac Projects is teaming up with SPI (or Sport Performance Institute) to offer cardiac screenings for a **tax deductible donation of \$85** per person, ages 5 & up.



Screenings are painless, quick & easy, only about 15 minutes.
